AN ORDINANCE NO. BR 2022-25

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE,
GEORGIA, ESTABLISHING SURPLUS PROPERTY
REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, it is desirable to enact regulations governing the disposal of City property which has become obsolete.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Blue Ridge, Georgia, as follows:

Section 1. Any property owned by the City which has become obsolete, or which has outlived its usefulness, or which has become inadequate for the public purposes for which it was intended, or which is no longer needed for public purposes, may be disposed of in accordance with procedures established by the City Administrator and in accordance with State law, so long as the property has been declared surplus by a motion of the City Council.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption on second reading.
