

RESOLUTION NO. BR2023-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLUE RIDGE, GEORGIA AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET AS OUTLINED IN THE ATTACHED DOCUMENT ENTITLED “BUDGET AMENDMENT #2” AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-81-6 and Section 6.24 (“Operating Budget”) of the City’s Charter, the City Council of the City of Blue Ridge shall adopt a budget ordinance or resolution and make appropriations in such sums as the governing authority may deem sufficient; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Blue Ridge approved and adopted the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget at a meeting on October 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.27 (“Changes in Budget”) of the City’s Charter provides that “[t]he city council, by majority vote, may make changes in the appropriations contained in the current operating budget at any regular meeting or special or emergency meeting called for such purposes;” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-81-3, any amendments to the budget shall be adopted by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Blue Ridge, upon the recommendation of the City Administrator, feels that it is necessary to amend the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Blue Ridge does hereby approve and adopt the amendments to the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget as outlined in the attached document entitled “Budget Amendment #2” and authorizes the City

Administrator to do all things necessary to carry out the aims of this Resolution. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Council Member Whaley who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Council Member Bivins, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
